IT IS ORDERED that the following persons are hereby appointed to the Mohave County Committee on Court Reporter Appointments to evaluate applicants in this regard for the new Superior Court Division V court reporter position and any other reporter position vacancies which become available between the effective date of this order and June 30, 1997.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if a court reporter applicant passes the examination, the committee shall prepare a certificate to that effect showing the number of words per minute written and transcribed and attach it to the matter read to the applicant, or a copy thereof, and the original notes and transcript made by the applicant. The certificate and other required information cited above shall be filed with

the Superior Court Clerk's Office in Mohave County with a copy to the Mohave County Court Administratory, Office.
