WHEREAS, on August 11, 1999, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Mohave County issued Administrative Order 99-43 which mandated the Mohave County Board of Supervisors to allocate \$867,234 in additional funds for Mohave County judicial branch operations in FY 2000; and

**OPERATIONS** 

WHEREAS, on October 29, 1999, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Mohave County issued Administrative Order 99-50 which stayed Administrative Order 99-43 subject to specified terms and conditions in that order; and

WHEREAS, judges and representatives of the judicial branch in Mohave County have attempted to negotiate a settlement with the Mohave County Board of Supervisors through the Board's representative, County Manager and/or staff (addressing emergent conditions related to court personnel, constitutionally and/or statutorily mandated care items and juvenile detention) during separate meetings on December 7, 1999, March 17, 2000, and the week of April 24, 2000; and

WHEREAS, on April 19, 2000, in an effort to address the ongoing emergency conditions, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court submitted a proposed settlement agreement to the Mohave County Board of Supervisors, which would have reduced and pro-rated from May 1, 2000, the amount ordered for the Mohave County Court System from \$867,234 to \$310,033 due to the passage of time and the reduction of certain budget items as a good faith gesture to the county; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2000, the Mohave County Board of Supervisors adopted a response to the proposed settlement agreement which allows for the possibility of supplemental funding required to reasonably address the unanticipated costs associated with the Superior Court's provision of constitutionally and/or statutorily-mandated services but in no way addresses any of the other emergent conditions; and

WHEREAS, the following principles of law are unquestioned:

- The judicial branch of government is and must remain an independent and autonomous branch of government.
- The Supreme Court, such intermediate appellate courts as provided by law, the superior court, and justice courts are all part of an integrated judicial department in the State of Arizona as provided by Arizona Constitution, Article 6 §1.
- The presiding judge in each county is vested by the Arizona Supreme Court through Administrative Order 96-32 with administrative responsibility for all courts in the county, be they the superior court or justice courts, along with the operation of the clerk of the superior court's office and other operations necessary for the administration of justice.
- The presiding judge has authority to order that additional funds be provided to support the court system as long as such order is not arbitrary, capricious or unreasonable. (See, e.g., Mann v. County of Maricopa, 104 Ariz. 561 (1969), and its progeny).

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Orders 99-43 and 99-50 are hereby rescinded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Mohave County Board of Supervisors, through the County Manager and County Treasurer, along with those subject to their supervision and control, immediately increase funding to the judicial branch in Mohave County by \$310,033 in accordance with the summaries set forth in Exhibit A and as provided through supportive administrative orders set forth in Exhibit B.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Mohave County Treasurer pay any and all claims or other expenses submitted to that office pursuant to this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the FY 2001 baseline amount for the Superior Court general fund budget be increased to reflect at minimum the additional \$213,967 supplemental budget increase shown on Exhibit A. In addition, the new baseline should include complete year funding for the new positions (i.e. personnel manager, secretary, contract security officers) beginning July 1, 2000.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the FY 2001 baseline amounts for the Clerk of the Superior Court's Office, Justice Courts, and Juvenile Detention general fund budgets be increased to reflect complete year funding for the above identified supplemental budget and staff increases for those departments.
