KINGMAN - CERBAT JUSTICE COURTS

WHEREAS the Kingman and Cerbat Justice Courts operate in a single facility, and use a single support staff, and

WHEREAS the Kingman and Cerbat Justice Courts have consolidated the docket and manage the distribution of cases equally, and

WHEREAS the County Board of Supervisors has supported by Resolution the equal division of productivity credits, and

WHEREAS the Justices of the Peace of the Kingman and Cerbat Justice Courts have agreed to use their respective grant funds as single grants for the support of the combined operation of the Kingman and Cerbat Courts, and

WHEREAS greater efficiency, use of staff resources, and improved accountability will result,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the bookkeeping and accounting procedures of the Kingman and Cerbat Justice Courts be consolidated to operate as a single system using common account and court numbers, and banking accounts to the greatest extent practical.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this change shall be effective July 1, 2000.
